

The Playground House Rules & Guidelines

Welcome to your first event at our RI Playground! The owners and hosts want you to have an amazing experience, whether you are a veteran, or lifestyle newbie couple or single. Below we have provided you with some guidelines and house rules to help make your evening pleasant.

- No means no, if someone says no, do not ask again. If they change their mind, they will let you know.
- Do not touch anyone without asking and receiving verbal consent.
- Do not have expectations to play. No one is obligated to participate. We are a “no pressure to play” party.
- Know how to handle your liquor and do not overdrink.
- Dress to impress themes are for fun but not mandatory
- NO CELL PHONES ON THE THIRD FLOOR OR IN THE BASEMENT. NEVER TAKE PICS WITHOUT CONSENT and make sure other guests are not in the camera's view. We must respect everyone's privacy. We will ask you to open your phone and delete the pictures.
- We use a wristband system. Pink is for single ladies, Black for single men, White for couples interested in only couples and checkered for couples interested in all. The stripe band identifies staff for your convenience.
- If a play session is in effect with a door open DO NOT go past the door unless you are invited in. Verbal Consent! Also NEVER open or peek a closed curtain or door.
- Respect the house, we clean and disinfect rooms and expect that you leave it the way we presented it. Do not throw condoms, wrappers and wipes on the floor or leave anything on tables. Trash cans are located all over the common areas and bedrooms.
- Pay attention to all the signs. They are there as a reminder.
- Couples/partners you must arrive and leave together. Please check on your partner throughout the evening.
- No open play in common lounge areas. It's only allowed on the third floor and basement.
- If you make a connection, be sure to have clear communication between all participants. Know what their do's & don'ts are and be sure you have consent from spouses.
- Most importantly inform your hosts and/or security immediately of any issues while on premise so we can act accordingly. It's very difficult to do anything the day or week after.
- The third floor is NOT a lounging area. It is for playing, changing or locker use ONLY. Do not hang out there. REMINDER: To enter the open playroom you must be completely undressed and in a towel or robe only.
- There is a limit of one towel per person per night. So please keep it either in your locker or on your body.
- If you can't make it, let us know. We usually have a waitlist of guests looking to attend. We keep a balanced ratio so we appreciate being contacted to keep the balance.

We pride ourselves at the Playground in offering a fun safe lifestyle friendly home for our guests to enjoy. Our intentions are for you to feel comfortable, like in your own home. The rules you read above will make your experience a positive one. Continuing on with the evening means that you certify that you understand and will follow all rules and acknowledge that if you break any rules you will be removed without a refund from our property and possibly banned from attending any future events.
